West Malvern Social Club WMSC Rules

1. introduction

These rules are in addition to the Constitution of the West Malvern Social Club. These rules must not be inconsistent with any provision of the Constitution.

The Rules are made either by an AGM or by a meeting of the WMSC trustees by majority decision of those present.

2. rules inherited from the old rules of the WMSC

2.1 honorary life membership

Life members may be elected by a two thirds majority at an Annual General Meeting, and shall be exempt from paying further subscriptions.

2.2 club management

The President of the club shall be the Rev. Vicar of St James Parish, West Malvern.

2.3 club officers

The Officers of the Club shall be a Chairman, a Secretary, and a Treasurer.

2.4 trustee meetings

The trustees shall meet as required, when they shall receive: reports from the Secretary and Treasurer; all correspondence; suggestions, complaints and views of the Club members, with respect to the general running of the Club, via the trustee. Club members may be co-opted to the trustee meeting at its discretion.

2.5 election of trustees

The Chairman may chair the AGM with the invitation of the President. The Secretary shall display on the Club notice board for a period of not less than fourteen days, an invitation for nominations to fill the trustee vacancies that have or will have arisen. The notice will provide for the name and signature of the nominee and the signature of both the proposer and seconder. If there are fewer nominations than vacancies the trustees may co-opt any Club members they deem fit to be a trustee.

2.6 licensing hours

The permitted hours for the supply of intoxicating liquor shall be those specified by the local licensing authority. The Club shall open at the discretion of the trustees within the permitted hours.

2.7 independent examiner

The Club shall have its annual accounts examined by an independent examiner.
